Basic Adult Leader Outdoor Orientation (BALOO) Training is required for any Cub Scout Pack offering Pack Family Camping trips other than the council or district family camping at Quail Hill. For example, if your pack wants to plan a family camping weekend at Allaire State Park or Sandy Hook (just to name a few) you will need a BALOO-trained leader on that trip.
